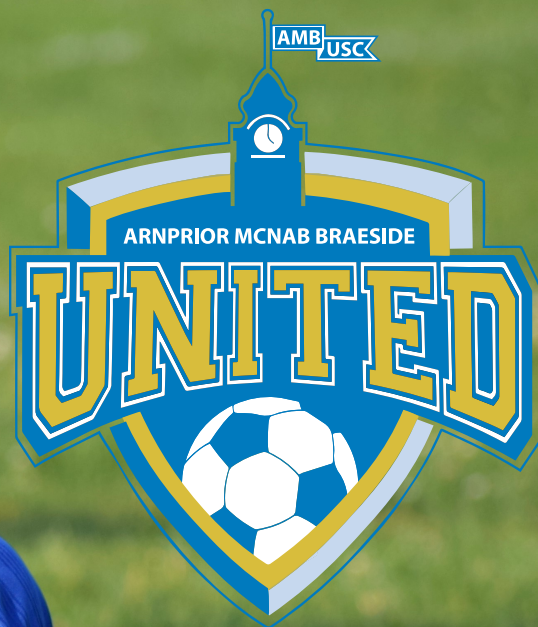

As a coach...

- You are expected to come to soccer each week prepared with a program to carry through your session. Outlines, training resources and helpful tools to run drills will be provided to you.
- You are expected to communicate with the Director of Mini Soccer any concerns or issues that arise throughout the year.
- You are expected to communicate with your Manager and the parents on your team about events and updates throughout the year.
- You are expected to behave in a respectful manner with a positive attitude as a role model.

As a manager...

- You are expected to assist the coach by being the communicator for your team. You will be the voice from the coach to the parents. This can include arranging snack schedule, communicating news and events or cancellations.
- You are not expected to lead sessions unless arranged with the coach.

As a parent...

- You are expected to arrive on time with your child.
- You are expected to show your coach and your manager respect at all times. Please remember that everyone within AMBUSC are volunteers who take time out of their day to bring these programs to your child.
